FACTS & FIGURES

- In 2021, Americans consumed 100.53 quadrillion BTUs of energy. About 79% of the energy consumed in the US came from fossil fuels.
- As of the date this content, the average price per gallon of gas in the U.S. was between \$3.68 and \$4.84.
- Every hour of idle time burns on average 1 gallon of gasoline in medium to large trucks.





SOME WAYS TO MANAGE FUEL EXPENSES

- On-site fueling
 - For the largest fleets, on site fueling may be the best plan. Pump providers have a variety of systems to track what driver, what vehicle, quantity dispensed and date/time stamp.
- Commercial Fuel cards
 - Card systems like Oil Company credit cards and Fuelman offer a variety of programs, some with additional sponsor perks like availability for integration. They may not be accepted at all service stations, so be sure to consider their provider footprint.
- Other commercial purchase cards
 - Other cards like Coast offer perks like cost savings, while offering more control and more flexibility.



THE BIGGEST FUEL WASTERS

- Unnecessary idling.
- Poor route planning – driving those extra miles.
- Poor vehicle maintenance.
- Wrong vehicle for the job (undersized)
- Aggressive driving habits –
 - Speeding
 - Hard acceleration



ECO FRIENDLY TIP FOR FLEETS

- By implementing a comprehensive fuel management program that includes driver training, vehicle maintenance optimization, and the use of telematics systems to monitor and control idle time, a 10% reduction in fuel consumption across the fleet is an achievable goal.
