FACTS & FIGURES

According to  NHTSA

- Almost one-third of traffic fatalities are speed-related crashes
- 28% of fatal crashes, 13% of injury crashes, and 9% of property-damage-only crashes in 2021 were speeding-related
- Speeding endangers everyone on the road: in 2022, speeding killed 12,151 people.





EXCESSIVE SPEED OR DIFFERENCE IN SPEED

- Keeping up with the flow of traffic makes sense, but then how fast becomes too fast?
- When another driver tailgates and darts in and out of moving traffic, how does that make you feel?
- Under what conditions do you consciously slow down?



ADJUSTING TO ROAD CONDITIONS

- How much do you think you need to slow down when it is raining?
- How much do you think you need to slow down when it is foggy?
- How much do you think you need to slow down when it is icy?
- How much do you think you need to slow down when it is snowing?
- What other conditions alert you instinctively to slow down?

THE CHALLENGE
